

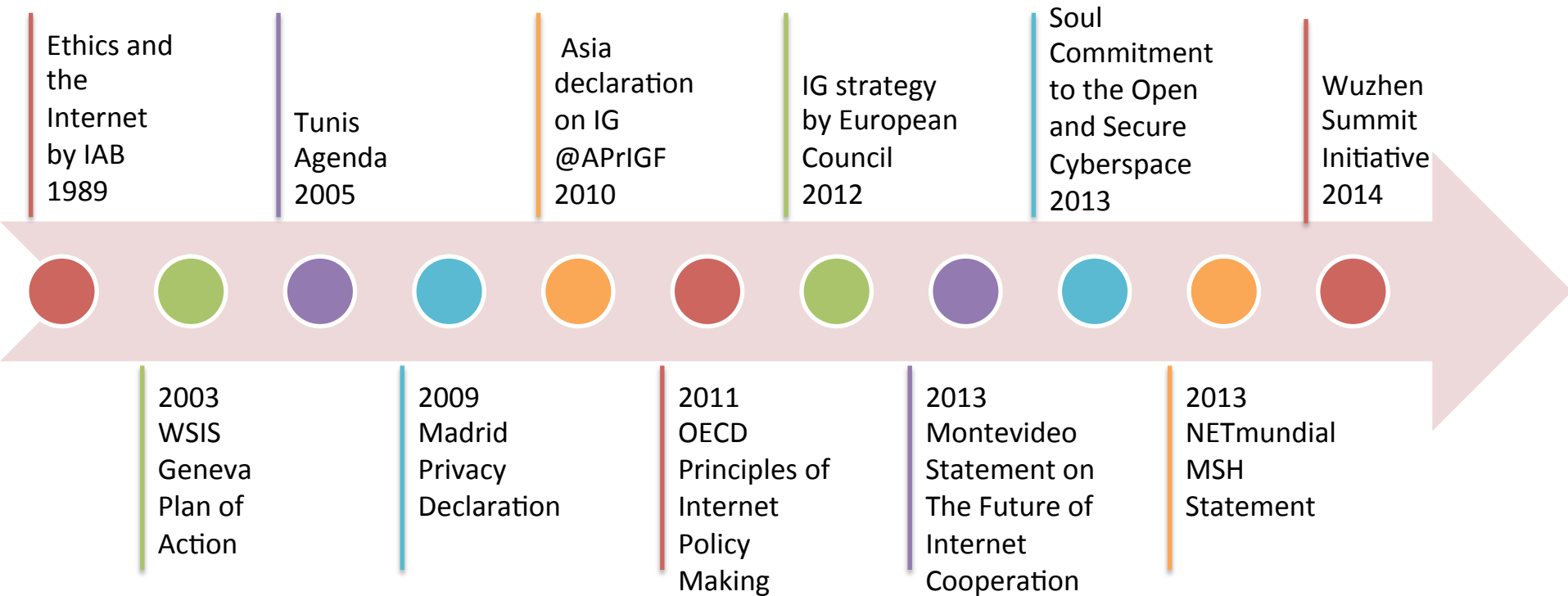

# Why we propose this dialogue?

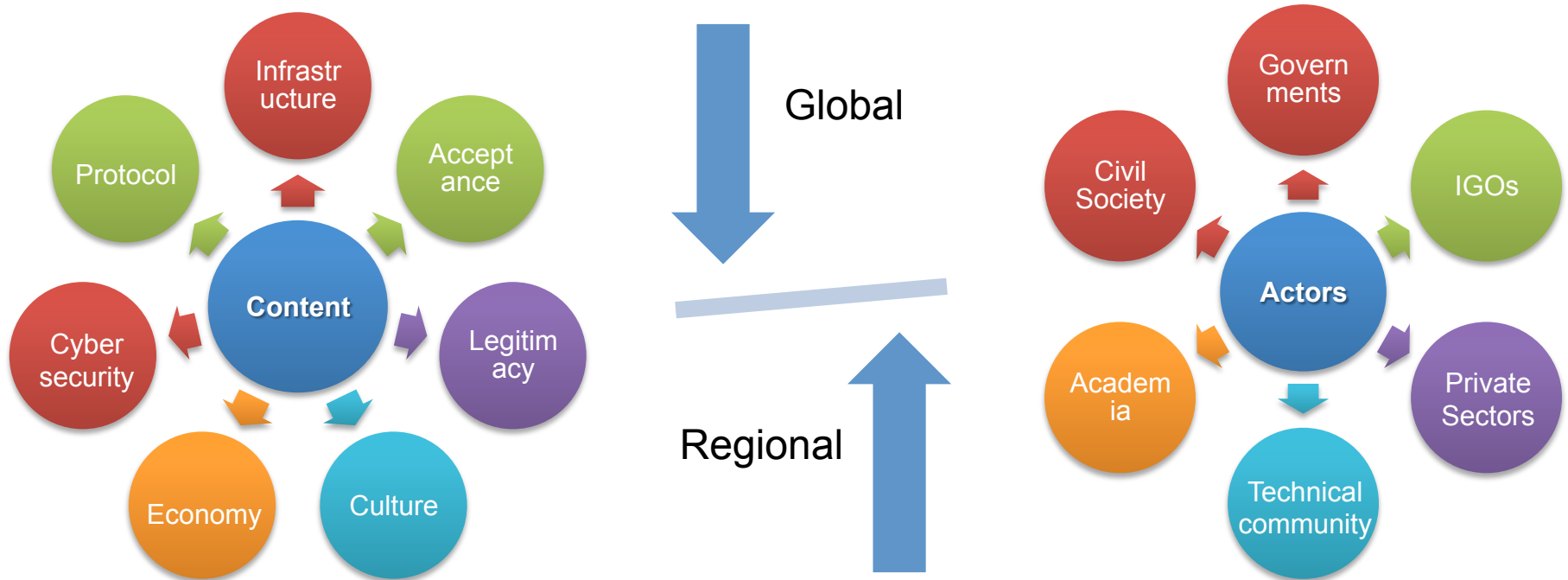
During the last 25 years, the endeavors in producing the principles of the IG never stopped.





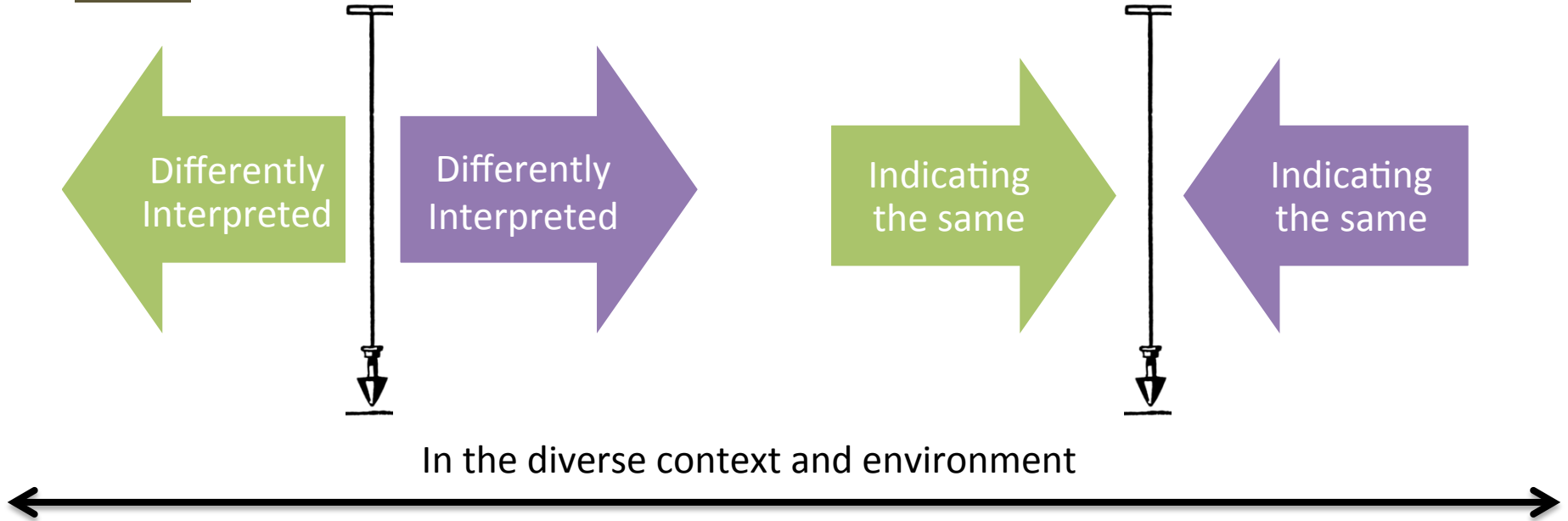
# Why we propose this dialogue?
